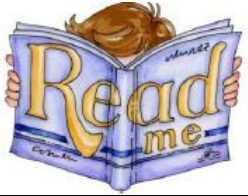


In English we will be learning...

In Maths we will be learning...

- Measure – to compare, estimate and calculate

- Fractions – Add and Subtract, finding fractions of quantities and fractions in the context of measure and equivalent fractions

In Science we will be learning...

States of matter

We will identify the states of matter and their associated properties.

We will experiment with the states of matter and draw our conclusions on how these change and the reasons why these changes occur.

We will learn about the particles in each state, how they are structured, what causes them to change and why.

We will learn about the water cycle- evaporation, condensation and precipitation.
