



Nursery's Coverage of Work

Week Beginning 27th September

This week in nursery we will be talking about what we like to play with and the things we like to do with our families. Developing positive and responsive relationships with adults, and other children, are fundamental to your child's development. Through positive relationships, children learn how to think, understand, communicate, behave, express emotions and develop social skills.

Literacy

We will be singing the Joly Phonic letter rhymes and actions. Can you hear the sound your names starts with?

We will be sharing the story 'I'm Special, I'm me!' about a little boy who, through his imagination, can be whoever he wants to be!

Listening Lola

In small groups we will play 'Move the Keys'. We will take it turns to see if we can pick up the keys and carry them to Lola without the keys jangling!

Maths

We will be making large wave movements using fabric squares as we recite numbers to 10! We will be singing number songs 1,2,3,4,5 Once I caught a fish alive..... and Five Little Monkeys jumping on the bed.

Creative

We will be sponge printing to make some owls from our story and together we will make a mother owl for our class display.

We will introduce Rosie's Ring. Learning the names and creating lots of percussion sounds.

In movement and dance we will be 'swooping' and flying like an owl.

Physical/Outdoor learning

We will practise using scissors to cut snips in paper strips to make owl feathers. In the outdoor classroom we will use a variety of moulds to make shapes in the sand.

Please remember to name your child's water bottle, coat and lunch box, if they have one. This saves a lot of upset for the children, especially if they have the same as their friend.
