Personal, Social & Emotional

This week the children will bring home a felt square. We are going to make a 'Personality Quilt' to display in school. The children can decorate the square at home with your help, using different resources, photos and pictures of the things they like and their family. Please bring them back to Nursery when completed. The children really like to talk about their family and the things that are special to them, and how they decorated their square.

Literacy

We will be playing sound games and going on a sound walk – what sounds can you hear? We will listen to different sound makers and will repeat a rhythm.

Listening Lola

We will listen to some calming music as we pass a balloon carefully around the circle without the balloon touching the ground!

Maths

Our number rhyme of the week is Five Currant Buns in a bakers shop.....

We will be counting with Floppy to see how many children are at nursery each day.

Creative

We will be painting a picture of a smiley face. What colours will you use? What makes you feel happy.

Rosie's Ring – We will explore the sounds we can make playing Boomwhacker!

Physical/Outdoor learning

We will be encouraging the children to have a go at putting on their coat independently, something they can practise at home. Showing them how to take their coat off by pulling on the cuff will ensure the sleeves are not inside out.

In the outdoor classroom we will use a variety of large apparatus to build a house. What can we use to make the roof?
