



Nursery's Coverage of Work - Week Beginning 12th October

We are reading the story Handa's Surprise celebrating Black History month. A story about a little girl who puts seven different delicious fruits in a basket to take to her friend Akeyo. However, Handa's walk takes her past a variety of animals, and the fruits *do* look very inviting.....

Phonics

This week we will be learning about rhyme and rhythm playing Bingo and 'Rhyming soup' games. It is important the children listen to and sing a stock of nursery rhymes. For children learning English as an additional language, songs and rhymes help them to tune into the rhythm and sound of English.

Literacy

This week we will be talking about Autumn. What can you see? We will be reading 'We're Going on a Leaf Hunt!' and 'Don't put your finger in the jelly, Nelly!' By Nick Sharratt. If you have a favourite rhyming story, please bring it in and we can read it together. We will be exploring our sense of hearing and introducing new words to describe what we can hear.

Maths

We will be singing the number rhyme, Ten fat sausages..... and reciting numbers to 10. Please bring to school any leaves you collect if you go out for an Autumn walk, we will sort the leaves by size and shape.

Creative

We will be printing with fruit and vegetables. We will print with the leaves you have collected; what colours can you see?

Physical/Outdoor learning

In the big hall we will be practising different ways of moving. Can you hop, jump, skip and shuffle?

We will be balancing bean bags on our heads, just like Handa who carries the basket of fruit on her head when she visits her friend.
