

Nurseries Coverage of Work

Week Beginning 15th November

This week in phonics we will be hearing and saying the initial sounds of the objects Floppy has in his box. Can you hear and say the first sound of your name? We will be sorting familiar objects which start with the same initial sound into sets; snake, spider, sock.....

In circle time we will be talking about what we know about Christmas and find out how different cultures celebrate Christmas. We will look at what is the same and what is different.

We will be sharing the stories; 'Do you want to be my Friend?' By Eric Carle. 'Making Friends' and 'Too Shy for Show and Tell'. Do you have a favourite story you like to hear over and over again?

In art we will be creating a design for our Christmas card. The children will share their ideas and look at the skills we will need to learn. We will make a list of the resources we will need to use.

In maths we will be subitising! Using the numicon trays, large dice and other resources to play games to be able to say the amount you can see without counting. You have to be quick! Follow the link below to find out more about subitising.
