GREAT NEWS! The Hotshots school basketball club will be re starting on THURSDAY 14th & FRIDAY 15th OF SEPTEMBER, the club times will be (Every THURSDAY 5.00 – 5.45pm YEARS 3&4) & (Every FRIDAY Lunchtime YEARS 2&3) and will run EVERY week throughout the whole year. If you are in year 3 and you have a preferred day please indicate it on the form.

There are 28 places at the club for the children. The places will be on a **first come first served** basis. Should your child wish to attend the basketball club we ask that the parents fill in the form and email a CLEAR PHOTO of the form to:

No later than 5pm THIS <u>"TUESDAY 12th SEPTEMBER"</u>. All children that get into the club will be notified by WEDNESDAY by 5pm.

Please note if your child attended the basketball club last year will have a place reserved, <u>however</u> they must still have their slip filled in and returned by **Tuesday** at 5pm or their place <u>maybe lost</u>.

The cost of the club is £4per session, and the subs are £52 for the term (13 sessions @ £4). Payments will be made directly to the coach or via BACS(details to follows). Please ensure that this is given into the COACH at the first session or bacs by Friday 15th of SEPTEMBER. (Please note if your child is on PUPIL PREMIUM there place maybe FREE, please see the school office to see if their place can be funded).

All children who gain a place at the basketball club must get changed into their PE kit and meet in the school hall every week on their allocated day. Whilst at the club, the children will be taught a variety of skills and rules, as well as playing in matches & tournaments against other hotshots clubs. There will also be prizes such as basketballs, t-shirt, certificates and monthly awards for the children to win.
