WW1 Armistice 100th Anniversary – This year sees the centenary anniversary of the end of World War 1. Parking Patrol – Will begin again after half term. 1S will be the first class starting on Tuesday 30 October.

Term dates – 2018-2019 term dates are available on the Central Bedfordshire Council website and our own website. Dates are subject to change so please refer to CBC regularly.

Online payments and booking system – A log in code was sent before the summer break. This enables you to register on the Tucasi/Schools cash office system. Once registered you can 'top up' your account with credit directly from your bank account. Once your account is in credit you will be able to book the school lunches your child would like up to a day in advance, your account will be debited £2.30. Any dinners not taken will be credited back to the account. With breakfast and after school clubs, where possible please book a week in advance and can only be made when the account is in credit. You can now book a day in advance and cancel sessions online. Any sessions booked but not taken will be credited back to your account as long as 24 hours' notice has been given that you will not require the session. If you have not received your registration code, please let the school office know.

Absences and your child's education – Headteachers had a reminder this week of the huge impact that absence has on a child's progress and development. Did you know that children who have a 100% attendance rate at school are twice as likely to achieve their potential? You can best support your child's education and development by avoiding any unnecessary absences during term time.

Reminder: Medical Appointments During School Time – This is a reminder to parents that if your child is late into school due to a medical appointment, or is collected early from school, documented evidence of this appointment is required. This can be an appointment card or a copy of an email. We are also aware that many surgeries send a confirmation text which is also acceptable proof. If proof of appointments cannot be given the child will be marked as an unauthorised absence.
